<u>Rules</u>

Round 1

- The participants would be given 2 codes to debug.
- There would be basic syntax errors in the code (No Logical Errors)
- The code given for debugging would be either in C , C++ or Java .
- The participant can choose any one language which he/she would like to debug the code in .
- After debugging the participants would have to solve a small puzzle or would be given a small game to complete. For Example : Maze
- The Time of completion would be noted and the participants who will finish the round in the least time would be selected for the Second Round .







Round 2

- The participants would be given some amount of game money which they will be using in the round to make some purchases.
- The participants would be provided with a set of problem statements.
- Each problem statement would have a certain price.
- The participants will have to purchase the problem statement which they would want to solve by the game money given to them.
- The participants would be rewarded the money according to the test cases they could successfully run.
- On successful running of all the test cases the participants would get a profit on the amount they invested on the problem statement.
- The top two participants with the maximum amount of game money with them at the end of the round would be the winners.
