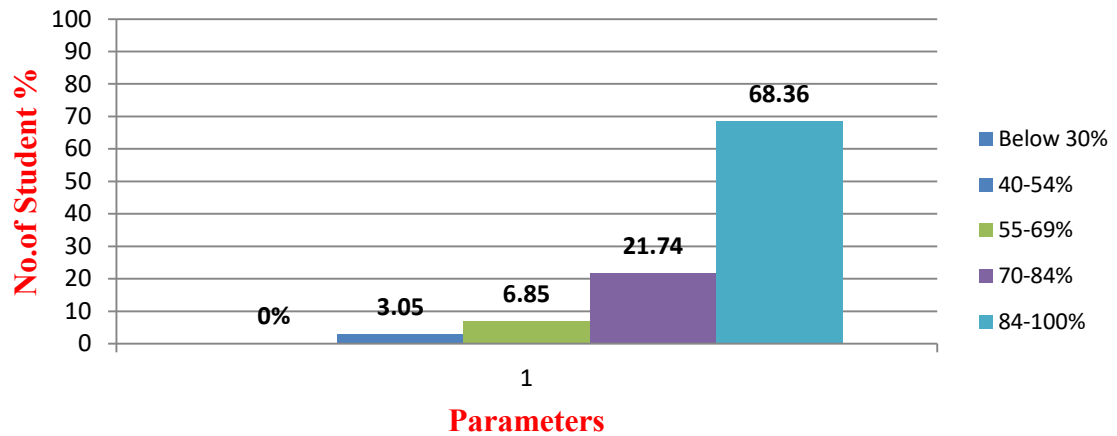

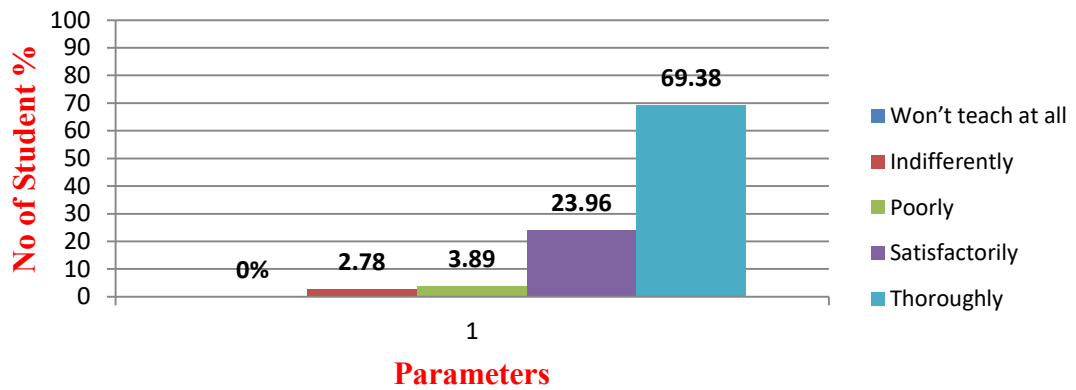

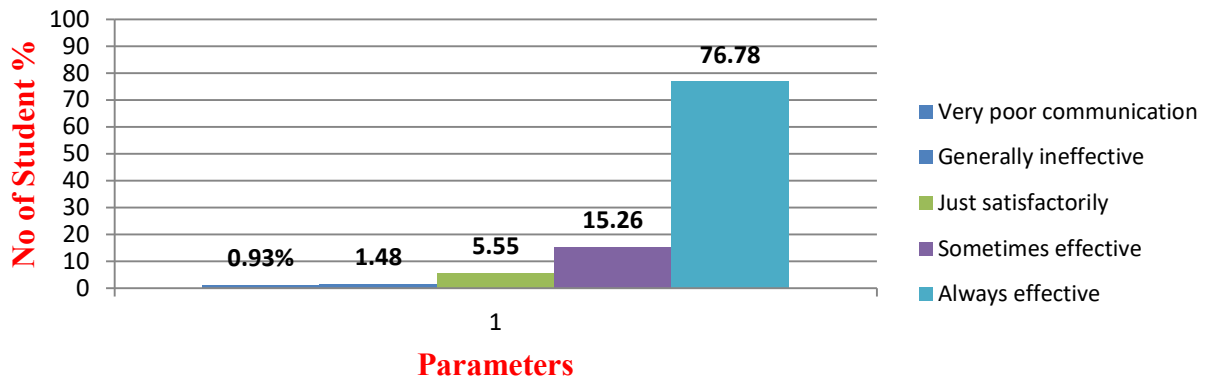
#### Question 1: How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



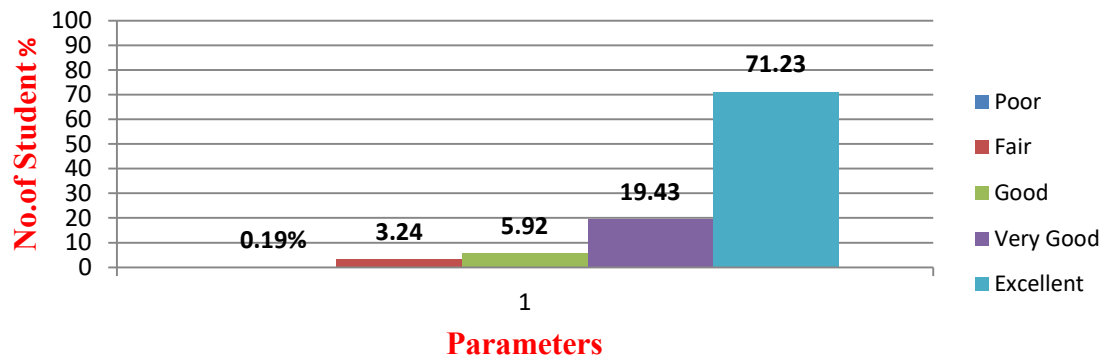

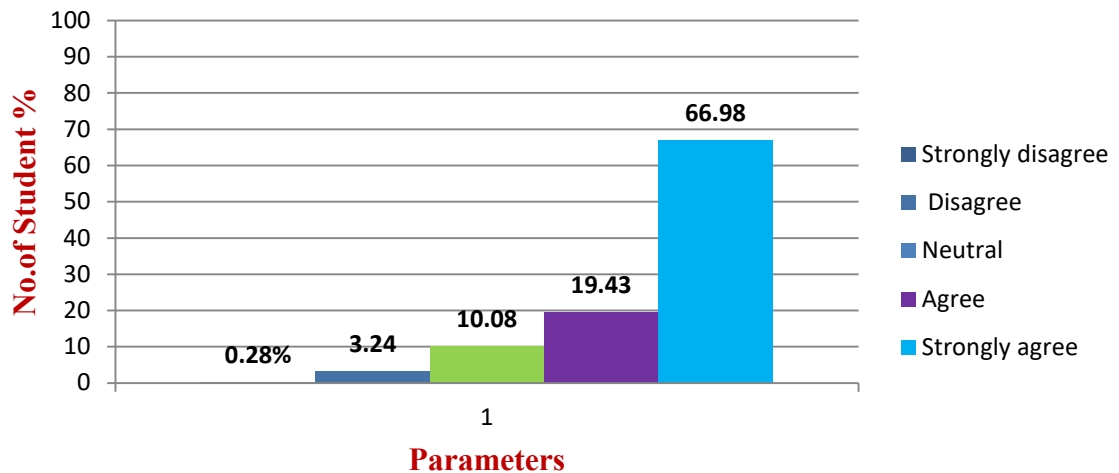
