From the Chairman's Desk.....

The discovery of photovoltaic cells led to the use of green energy sources such as global solar energy supplies that are growing rapidly; The installed capacity of solar energy in India has witnessed a large increase between 2014 and 2021. It is the second largest absolute generation growth of all renewable technologies, slightly behind wind and ahead of hydropower. However, even if these technologies offer cheaper and key to the unending power supply, the complication lies when the sun is not shining. The solution to this problem lies in storing and dispatching energy on demand using concentrating solar-thermal power. Solar thermal power plants are electricity generation plants that utilize energy from the sun to heat a fluid to a high temperature. This fluid then transfers its heat to water, which then becomes superheated steam. This steam is then used to turn turbines in a power plant, and this mechanical energy is converted into electricity by a generator. The first utility-scale solar-thermal plants were built in the 1980s. Out of 75 solar thermal power plants in the world, India has three of them.

Solar energy based decentralized and distributed applications have benefited millions of people in Indian villages by meeting their cooking, lighting and other energy needs in an environment friendly manner. Further, solar energy sector in India has emerged as a significant player in the grid connected power generation capacity over the years. It supports the government agenda of sustainable growth, while, emerging as an integral part of the solution to meet the nation's energy needs and an essential player for energy security. India currently stands third in Asia and fourth in the world in terms of solar power production across its plants, with solar accounting for about 40% of its total renewable energy capacity. The five major solar power projects in the country are The Bhadla Solar Park, which is the largest solar power plant in the world, is based in Bhadla village, in Rajasthan's Jodhpur district, installed with a capacity of 2,250MW, Shakti Sthala solar power project – 2,050MW, Ultra Mega Solar Park – 1,000MW, Rewa Solar Power Project – 750MW and Kamuthi solar power plant – 648MW.

In India the first Solar Thermal Power Plant of 50kW capacity has been installed by MNES following the parabolic trough collector technology (line focussing) at Gwalpahari, Gurgaon, which was commissioned in 1989 and operated till 1990, after which the plant was shut down due to lack of spares. The plant is being revived with development of components such as mirrors, tracking system etc. Currently three solar thermal power plants operate in India. They are namely (i) Dhursar in Jaisalmer, Rajathan having a capacity of 125 MW using Fresnel reflector, (ii) Godawari Green Energy Limited in Nokh Village, Rajasthan having a capacity of 50 MW using Parabolic trough and Megha Solar Plant in Anantapur with a capacity of 50 MW using Parabolic trough.

India, through different solar and solar thermal projects is reaching as world's leading solar power production. As future engineers, the engineering students of the country must be aware of the upcoming technologies.







Steps to establish IEI Students' Chapters in

Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnics

Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnics may establish Students' Chapter of IEI with atleast fifty students pursuing engineering in the same branch of a College/University/Institution and be a part of the IEI fraternity following steps below:

- Initial request from an engineering college/a polytechnic is to be made to the Director (Membership) of IEI expressing desire to open a Students' Chapter at the Engineering College/Polytechnic mentioning the branches of engineering.
- (i) In a College/University/Institution, at least **fifty numbers (50)** of students irrespective of the year of study in the same branch of engineering is required for opening a Students' Chapter.
 - (ii) To enable formation of a Chapter in any recognized polytechnic minimum number of member required is **fifty (50)**. There shall be only one Chapter in a polytechnic.

This strength of membership shall be mandatory for opening as also for continuing a Students Chapter. However, it's requested to motivate all the students to enroll themselves in the chapter.

- Upon obtaining the permission and code of the new Students' Chapter from IEI, prospective Chapters have to download the forms [for engineering college Students' Members (ECSC) and Polytechnic Students' Member (PSC)] from the webpage www.ieindia.org. The forms have to be filled up by the students willing for members of Students' Chapter in consultation with the Adviser.
- The requisite fee to be collected from each student as per the year of study as given below.

- Reimbursement of travelling expenses to students selected for presentation of technical papers in Technicians'/Students' Convention of IEI.
- After passing the final year B.E/B.Tech examination, members of the Students' Chapter are eligible for the followings:

 - Associate Members are entitled to receive Chartered Engineer certificate on payment of requisite fee
 - SMIE members may become Associate Member at a discount in Registration fee, if they
 applied within 1 year of passing BE/BTech (the details is given in our AM application
 form).
- **85 nos** of Scholarships of **Rs 7,15,000/-** given to the engineering meritorious students attached to the different Student chapter.
- Dr Amitava Bhattacharyya Memorial Trophy to be awarded to three Best Engineering College Students' Chapters and three Best Polytechnics students Chapters are annually awarded the certificate, plaque and Rs 20,000/-, Rs 15,000/- and Rs 10,000/- in each category respectively.
