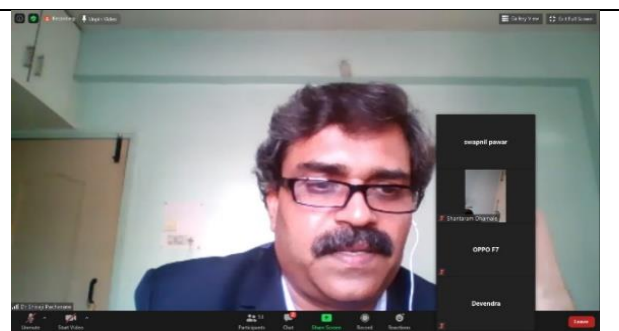

Shashikant Pitre Sir. was commissioned into course of engineers of Indian Army in 1962. During his conquered service spanning 36 years, he has served on the Western, Northern and Eastern Border. He is a Post Graduate in Military science and a Master of Engineering in Structures. He has qualified on various career courses in army including defense Service Staff College and higher command courses. He is a recipient of COAS commandant Card. After Retirement, he has written widely in marathi dailies in military matters. His daily columns in the circle during the Kargil war and in LokSatta during Afghanistan as well as Iraq were well received. He has authored a book on the Kashmir imbroglio, 'Domel te Kargil' (in marathi), which was adjusted as the Book of 2001 by Maharashtra Sahit Parishad. He has authored 4 other books; his latest book on 1962 war was received 5 prestigious awards. General Pitre Sir is founder Chairman of Ex- Serviceman Organization Horizon, dedicated to Humanitarian Demining. The General has been appointed as the trusty of service Preparatory Institute by the Government of Maharashtra.

Maj. Gen. Shashikant Pitre sir addressed the audience. He had prepared a presentation about the Kargil war and explained to us the situation of Indian Army where they tackled the situation and successfully took command of the high outposts which had been lost to Pakistan. This Kargil war was fought for about 40-60 days under minus 10 degrees temperature. The webinar carried out enlighten us, it was very intellectual. After this our Chief Guest answered some of our audience questions related to current issues between India and China.

All India Shri Shivaji Memorial Society's, College of Engineering, Pune-01, National Service Scheme unit arranged a webinar regarding NEP20. Education Policy lays particular emphasis on the development of the creative potential of each individual. It is based on the principle that education must develop not only cognitive capacities - both the 'foundational capacities' of literacy and numeracy and 'higher-order' cognitive capacities, such as critical thinking and problem solving – but also social, ethical, and emotional capacities and dispositions. The policy heads to transform India's education system till 2030.

The webinar included two sessions. In first session Prof. Prabhakar Desai Sir made it clear that this is just a policy not a law of constitution (cannot be applied all over country) and changes can be made in it. Prof Desai Sir also told that NEP has its pros and cons which means it's not fully beneficial. It focuses on critical and liberal thinking. This, policy is not just 60 pages rather its 400 pages policy.

He highlighted Principles of this Policy like: Policy will provide more focus on vocational studies in school-level. Various new provisions for children. Three language learned by children will be the choice of state, regions and students. Medium of instruction will be the local/ regional language. No hard separation of streams for students. There will be restructuring school curriculum and pedagogy in a new 5+3+3+4 design.

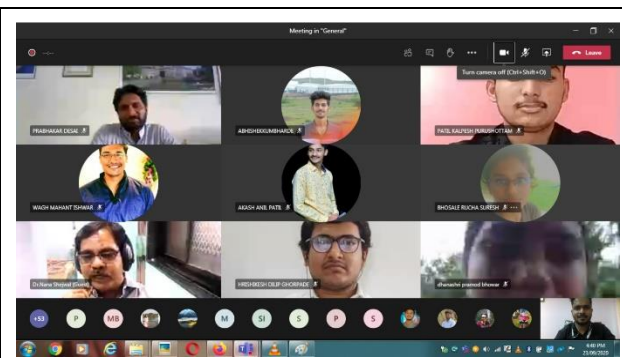
The second session included Question and answer.

In which participants were actively involved. Students asked about importance of change in policy and how to manage teaching the coding language to rural students where computers are not available? What are outcomes of NEP? Answering foremost questions Prof. Prabhakar Desai Sir cleared all doubts of students by saying that the implementation of education policy will be possible only in few sections.

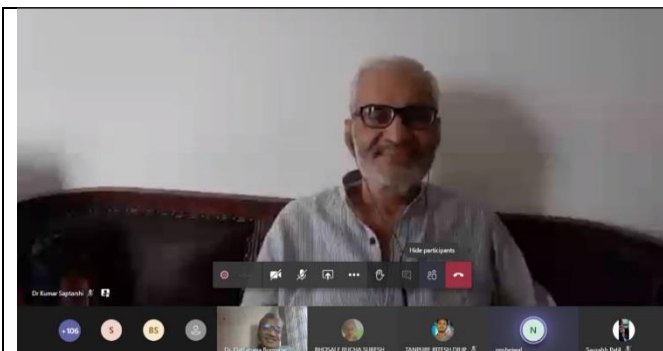

Around 300 participants attended through live streaming on You Tube. Dr. N.N. Shejwal Sir, then expressed the importance of Mahatma Gandhi's "go to the village" in the growing problems caused by the Corona epidemic. After that, Principal Dr. D.S.Bormane Sir, while expressing his thoughts, informed about the various activities being implemented by the students. Our host then introduced the Chief Guest to the audience. Dr. Kumar Saptarshi Sir, is the President of Maharashtra Gandhi Smarak Nidhi and Yuvak Kranti Dal Maharashtra. From an early age, Dr. Kumar Saptarshi Sir, dedicated his life for the welfare of the society. He did a lot of organizational work. His work was not limited to the city, he also did special work in rural areas. By choosing the path of code of conduct, in the interest of the country, by placing a Tulsi letter on the landlord, the agitation was carried out, and it was declared a success. In various movements, Dr. Kumar Saptarshi Sir, has been arrested for total 35 times in various movements. Salute to this patriotism. Dr. Kumar Saptarshi Sir, (Chief Guest), started the speech by paying homage to the image of Mahatma Gandhi. First, he elaborated on Gandhiji's concept of a self-reliant India. He also shared many examples of how humans exploited nature just out of their own greed and fear. He also underlined how the concept of 'Let's go to the village' can be realized through our activities. He warned that bringing progress and intelligence from the city to the village means moving towards the village. He said that they should be made self-reliant by eliminating social inequality in the village. He mentioned the Corona epidemic and the unfortunate rape that came to Hathras. He attributed this to patriarchal culture, backward thinking and the message of building a relationship of humanity. The younger generation should show the dictatorial and prosperous nations like China, through their hard work, that progress can also be made through democracy, individual freedom and so on. Later the students asked Dr. Kumar Saptarshi Sir, many questions about Mahatma Gandhi's view of self-reliant India. Dr. Kumar Saptarshi Sir, answered all the questions thoroughly and resolved all the doubts of the students.

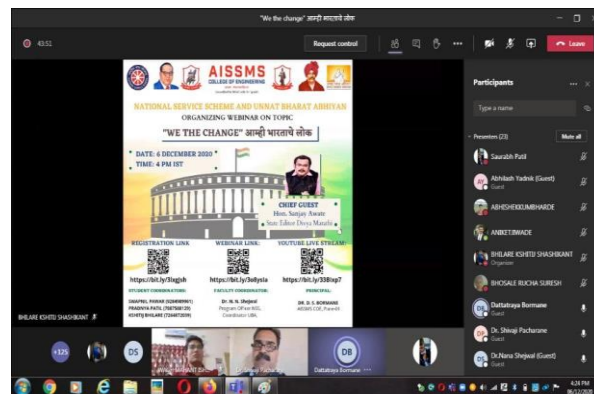
Then our anchor introduced our Chief Guest to the audience and welcomed them.

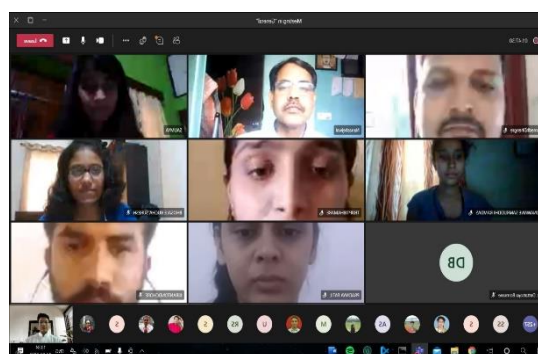
