
#### **Opportunities For Higher Studies In Germany**

REPORT - HALF DAY SEMINAR ON "Scale-up of batch process and flow chemistry in batch reactors" dated 19th Jul, 2019

(IIChE) Students' Chapter organized a half day seminar on "Scale-up of batch process and flow chemistry in batch reactors" on 19th July, 2019, venue: Department Seminar Hall, Room No. 442 at 1:00 p.m. onwards. The guest of honour was Mr. Chetan Shende, Senior Scientist, Dr. Reddy's Institute of Life Sciences, Hyderabad. Ms. Manali Kulkarni, TE Chemical welcomed the audience and anchored the event. Dr. P. N. Dange, Head- Department of Chemical engineering inaugurated the event and felicitated Mr. Chetan Shende by giving mementoand the Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj autobiography, the book of his remarkable societal work. In an inaugural speech, Dr. P.N. Dange initiated the purpose of this seminar and also emphasized the utility of this seminar to Chemical engineering students in their final year projects, in small businesses and entrepreneurship works. For newly admitted second year students, it is the value addition in knowledge point of view.

The talk was divided in two halves- the first part was explained on "scale-up of batch reactors" and the second on "flow chemistry of batchreactors".

In the first part, Mr. Shende explained the design scales - lab scale, pilot plant scale and commercial scale. He also explained the necessity to scale-up the plant. In connection to the plant scale-up Mr. Shende further emphasized on batch and continuous processes. The pharmaceutical companies are usually run on batch processes and there is a huge demand of Chemical Engineers in pharmaceutical sector. In designing the process he has given lot of





illustrations for selection of material for design and fabrication work. The knowledge of MOC (material of construction) is important in food and pharmaceutical sectors because of the need of high purity. The students of third year were enthusiastic and asked to give case studies regarding handling of acidic and basic materials. Mr. Shende answered that the acidic processes are carried out in Glass-lined reactors (GLR) and that of alkali in rubber-lined reactors (RLR). The life of reactor is important and accordingly it is replaced as per the maintenance and reactor life-span. In scaling the reactor from lab to pilot plant scale, the scale-up proportion is not linear. Therefore the designer should take at-most precaution to obey the National IS-standards.He further showed the criterion for fitting the right agitator blade to reactor. The example of anchor blade was really interesting for the students as it only rotates the entire mass of reactor without mixing. The final year students asked the question to manage the heat of reaction. Mr. Shende further elaborated the need of waste heat boiler, limpet coil construction and jacket tothe vessel to manage the heat of reaction. Mr. Shende encouraged the students to work in batch processes, especially for third and final year students on pharmaceutical projects.

Mr. Shende explained the concepts of flow chemistry and its industrial importance. The application is extended to micro-reactors. The micro-reactors are the small reactors having all the essential properties of industrial reactor. On the other part micro-fluids are having innumerous applications in industry especially in electronics. The micro-fluids can also be used in heat pipes, electronic circuitries, and in quality control laboratories. The flow chemistry essentially based on Newton's laws of viscosity. These fluids are further broadly classified as Newtonian, Nonnewtonian, Bingham plastic and dilatant. Mr. Shende emphasized that one should study the rheology of such fluids before their application. Mr. Shende, further showed stress-strain analysis and fluid properties that are essential before the applications. The second session was for almost one and half hour. Total fifty-five participants were present for the program.


