

Guidelines, Rules, and Regulations:

1. Eligibility:

• The competition is open to students from the first year to the fourth year of the college.

2. Registration:

- All participants must register online, through the official event website before the 1st round
 of Event.
- Participants must provide accurate and complete information during registration.

3. Original Work:

- All submissions, responses, and presentations during the competition must be the original work of the participants.
- Plagiarism or using external materials without proper citation is strictly prohibited.

4. Behavior:

- Participants are expected to demonstrate professionalism, respect, and sportsmanship at all times.
- Any form of disruptive behavior, cheating, or misconduct will lead to immediate disqualification.

5. Judges' Decisions:

- Decisions made by the judges and organizers will be final and binding.
- Any appeals or disputes will not be entertained.

6. Code of Conduct:

 All participants are required to adhere to the college's code of conduct and ethics throughout the event.

Selection Process:

There will be 3 rounds: -

1. Aptitude Test:

- It will be an objective test consisting of project manager's skill questions.
- Test will be of 40 minutes having 20 questions. (15 MCQ, 5 Give reasons in 2-3 lines)
- · No extra time will be given.
- Each right answer will be awarded as per assigning marks.
- · There will be no negative making for wrong answer.

2. Group Discussion: -

 Participants will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be given a topic and tenminutes will be given for discussion.

3. Personal Interview (Technical & HR): -

• This will be the final round with one-on-one interview with the expert panel.

General Instructions:

1. Attendance:

- Participants should arrive at the venue by 9:30 AM time for registration and event briefing.
- Each participant must bring their valid student identification proof for verification.

2. Devices and Attire:

- Electronic devices (laptops, tablets, phones) are allowed only during designated rounds.
- Business casual attire is required for all participants during the competition.
