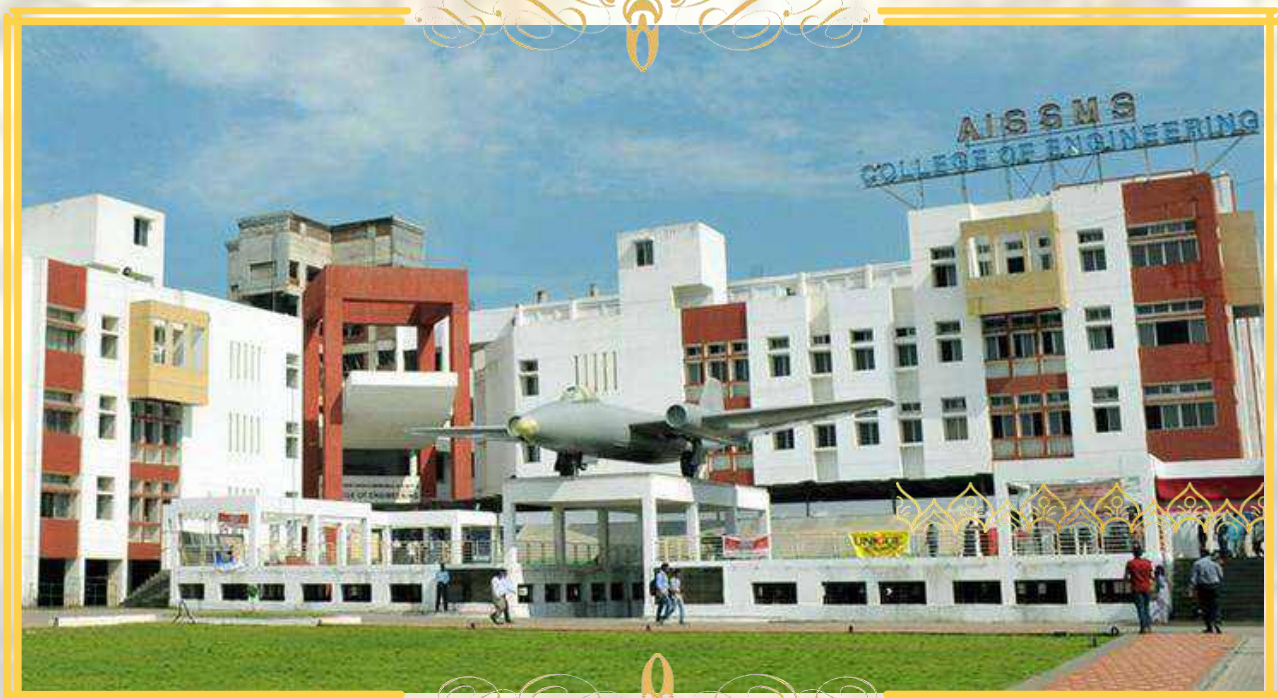

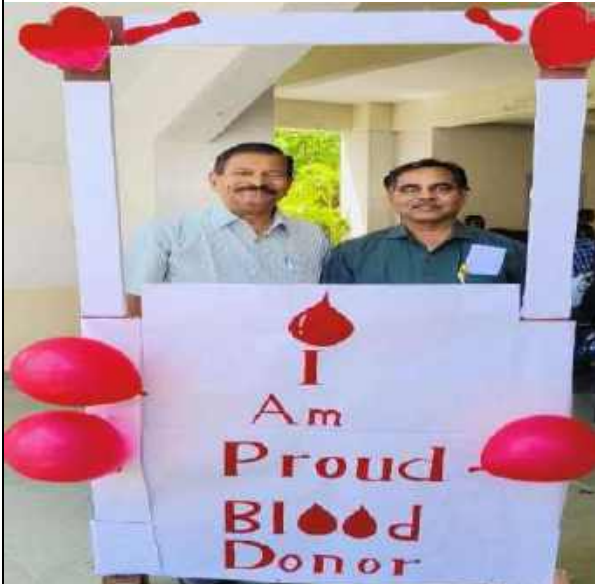

We have created a Google form for filling all the information. House survey contains questions like main source for drinking water, quality of drinking water, treatment on drinking water. We started this survey on 3rd February by visiting each house. We have formed 2 groups and visited each house in the village and started to fill the Google forms. There are about 300 houses in village. But many villagers are moved to other city. At that time there was 156 houses. We have done survey of 156 houses. There is scarcity of water in this village. The pipeline is provided for water but it is not used for drinking purpose. The water used for drinking purpose is of gram panchayat well which is situated at the starting of village. We have seen that majorly water is brought by females. Female of the house bring water 2 times a day from well. There is water scarcity in summer from the month of March to May. Then water is provided by tanker in village.

We also have done survey for topography. In this survey we have visited all the wells in village. There are 6 wells in the village. We Took the diameter, depth of the well and height of retaining wall. The water level is also measured.

Conclusion of survey: -

- Water scarcity in village.
- The villagers are relying on a single well for drinking water.
- 6 wells in the village.

All India Shri Shivaji Memorial Society's College of Engineering, Pune-01, National Service Scheme organized the Special Residential Camp in the Kalyan village, Tal. Haveli, Dist. Pune between 2nd-9th February 2024. In this camp various activities were performed by NSS unit, one of the most important activities was “**Geo Technical Survey**”.

The primary goal of this geophysical investigation was to assess the groundwater potential in a specific area. Various subsurface layer parameters were taken into consideration. This specific method included identifying a low-resistivity area that percolates water then sealing the fracture of 20-30 meters hole and filling it with cement. A machine that was used to find the resistivity area was the terametre SAS 300c. Firstly lateral survey was been conducted then the vertical electrical sound method was used from the least point of resistivity in the lateral survey to find seepage having low resistivity and high porosity based on these results various other surveys will be conducted. This survey is completed under the guidance of Aditi Shinde (student co-ordinator), Nagmaleah Gampala sir and Dr. N. N. Shejwal.

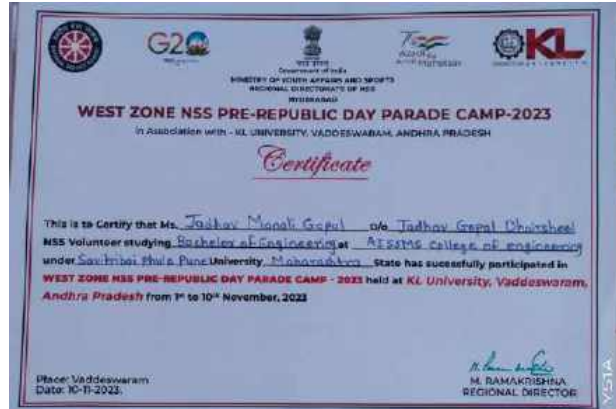

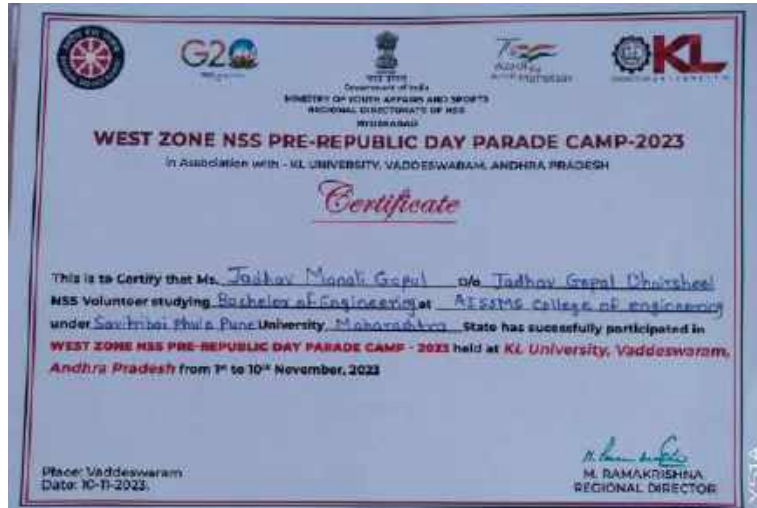
