Event Rules

1. The Laser War: License To Kill (EL1)

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Team size will be of maximum 3 students.
- 2. Entry fees is Rs. 300/- per teams.
- 3. The competition will be conducted in roundwise.
- 4. Each player has 5 lives. One hit on jacket sensor = -1 life.
- 5. When a player's life reaches 0, they are eliminated and must leave the arena immediately.
- 6. Players cannot block their sensors with hands, clothing, or objects.
- 7. Volunteers decision will be final.

Rules for Each Round:

Total Match Time: 5 minutes (can be adjusted).

Phase 1 (Defense Phase -0 to 3 minutes):

- Players must stay inside their own territory.
- No crossing into the opponent's area.

Phase 2 (Attack Phase – after 3 minutes):

- Players are allowed to enter opponent's territory.
- Flag can be targeted from this phase onward.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Team size will be of maximum 3 students.
- 2. Participation fee is Rs.300/- per team.
- 3. Each player attempts the wire path one by one.
- 4. If the probe touches the wire \rightarrow buzzer/light indicates penalty.
- 5. Player must continue from the same spot after penalty.
- 6. After completing the path, next teammate starts.
- 7. Total team time is recorded.
- 8. Perfomance of all 3 players is observed.
- 9. The wire uses only low-voltage DC supply (safe, non-harmful).
- 10. No touching the circuit directly by hand.
