EVENT CONCEPT:

The Space Quiz Challenge is an engaging event where students showcase their knowledge of space science, astronomy, and recent space missions. It focuses on analytical thinking, scientific awareness, and curiosity. The event encourages learning while promoting healthy competition among participants.

GENERAL RULES: -

- a) All teams must report to their respective offline venues or log in to the quiz platform on Unstop at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start time.
 - b) Offline participants must carry their college ID cards at all times. Online participants must use their full registered names on the Unstop platform.
 - c) Any form of misbehaviour, use of foul language, or lack of respect toward judges, faculty coordinators, or student volunteers will lead to immediate disqualification.
 - d) Professional attire is mandatory for all participants, whether presenting in person at AISSMS COE or virtually.
 - e) Participants are advised to ensure stable internet connectivity and complete all login formalities in advance to avoid last-minute issues. AISSMS COE is not liable for any internet disruptions, connectivity issues, or technical glitches faced by participants during the online quiz.
 - f) It is mandatory for all registered participants to join the official WhatsApp Group for real-time updates and further details.
 - g) The decision of the judges and the Organising Committee shall be final and binding. No further appeals will be entertained.

COMPETITION RULES: -

- a) This event is open to both individual participants and teams, and is open to Engineering, Diploma Students, Faculty Members and Industry Professionals.
- b) Each team can consist of a maximum of 4 participants.
- c) After filling out the Google Form, the team leader must also register for the event on Unstop.
- d) Two separate competitions will be conducted in online and offline modes. Winners will be evaluated and declared independently for each mode.
- e) The online competition will consist of three rounds. The average score of the first and second rounds will be considered for qualification to the final round. A total of two winners will be announced.
- f) For the offline competition, there will be three rounds: the first will be a MCQ round, the second will be a written test, and the third will be a rapid-fire round. Two winners will be announced for the same.
- g) All the three rounds of an offline competition will be conducted on 10th April.
- h) Qualifying round for an online competition will be conducted on 10th April and final round will be conducted on 11th April.
