### **EVENT CONCEPT:**

The Product/Prototype Competition is a hybrid event designed to provide a platform for budding engineers to showcase functional models or early-stage ventures. This track focuses on technical feasibility, innovation-driven thinking, and potential industry synergy.

---

### **GENERAL RULES: -**

- a) All teams must report to their respective offline venues or join the Zoom meeting at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start time.
  - b) Offline participants must carry their College ID cards at all times. Online participants must use their full registered names on the Zoom platform for attendance.
  - c) Any form of misbehaviour, use of foul language, or lack of respect toward judges, faculty coordinators, or student volunteers will lead to immediate disqualification.
  - d) Professional attire is mandatory for all presenters, whether presenting in person at AISSMS COE or virtually.
  - e) For the Product/Prototype competition, teams are responsible for the safety of their own hardware. AISSMS COE is not liable for any damage or loss of prototype components.
  - f) All tools and equipments required for the prototype demonstration must be brought by the participants themselves.
  - g) It is mandatory for all registered participants to join the official WhatsApp Group for real-time updates and further details.
  - h) The decision of the judges and the Organising Committee shall be final and binding. No further appeals will be entertained.

## **COMPETITION RULES: -**

- a) Product/Prototypes should ideally align with one of the following Sub-Themes:

  - **Renewable & Green Tech**
  - **Robotics & Drones**
  - **Semiconductor & Embedded Systems**
  - **AgriTech**
  - **HealthTech**
  - **FinTech**
  - **Defence & Aerospace**
  
- b) A maximum 10-slide PPT should be presented during the presentation explaining the Product/Prototype.
  
- c) Evaluation Criteria:
  - **Innovation:** Uniqueness of the idea.
  - **Technical Feasibility:** Robustness of the prototype design.
  - **Market Potential:** Alignment with the given Sub-Themes.
  - **Quality of Presentation:** Clarity during the Q&A session.

### **❖ ONLY FOR HYBRID (ONLINE MODE):**

- Outstation participants can attend online via the Zoom platform.
- Participants must ensure a high-speed, stable internet connection and a working webcam/microphone.
- The prototype must be demonstrated **live** on camera. Recorded videos are only permitted as a backup in case of temporary technical glitches, but the primary evaluation will be on the live functional test.
- All team members must keep their cameras **ON** during the presentation and the Q&A session for verification.
