4. MODE OF PARTICIPATION

5. There will be no abstract shortlisting.
6. Presentation round will be conducted for all valid submissions.

6. PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Paper must be submitted in PDF format.
2. Paper length shall be minimum 4 pages and maximum 6 pages.
3. Paper must follow IEEE standard format.
4. Paper must include Title, Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Literature Review, Methodology, Results, Conclusion, and References.
