🏆 Rules and Regulations Inter-Department Team Events

1. Eligibility

- **Participation restriction:** Students who have received YD (Year Drop) this year or have already passed out of the college are **not allowed** to participate.
- **Year-wise player limit:** Minimum **1 players from each year (SE, TE, BE)** are mandatory in a team. If the team fails to comply this rule the team will be disqualified.
- **Identity verification:** All participants must carry a valid I-Card, Bonafide certificate, and Fee receipt for verification.

2. Events

- **Sports list:** Football, Cricket, Badminton, Table Tennis, Chess, Volleyball, Basketball, Kabaddi.
- Both **men's and women's teams** will be organized.
- Each department can form **only one team per event**.

3. Team Formation

- **Department GS role:** The General Secretary (GS) of each department will assist in forming teams.
- Registration forms will be shared by the GS and must be submitted **one day before the event**. Departments failing to submit will not be allowed to participate.
- Teams must report **30 minutes prior** to the scheduled competition time at the respective venues.

4. Match Rules

- **Knockout format:** All matches will be knockout; no league matches.
- Lots will be drawn in the presence of all Captains and GS.
- The decision of referees/umpires is **final**. Misbehavior towards officials can lead to disqualification.
- Teams failing to report on time will be forced to **forfeit** their matches.



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5. Scoring System

- **Winner:** 20 points
- **Runner-up:** 16 points
- **Semi-finalists:** 12 points
- **Participation:** 2 points
- Scores will be added to the **overall trophy tally**.

6. Conduct & Discipline

- Teams must maintain discipline and respect towards referees, umpires, and opponents.
- Any misconduct will result in immediate disqualification.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to **change the program or schedule** if necessary.
- The declared schedule will **not be changed** for any reason.

7. Safety & Responsibility

- The organizing committee is **not responsible** for loss of personal belongings.
- The committee is **not responsible** for injuries; however, **First Aid** will be provided.

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1) Cricket (Men & Women)

- The team should consist of minimum 12 members and maximum 15 members each
- The match will be of 20 over each
- The match will be played with leather ball
- Balls and other equipment's like stumps, bails, etc will be provided by the college but students are allowed to carry their own equipment's as well.

2) Badminton (Men & Women)

- The team should consist of minimum 3 and maximum 5 members each
- Shuttlecock will be provided by the college and all other equipment's like shoes and racquets should be covered by the students
- The match will be played with synthetic shuttlecock
- The matches will be in best of 3 modes wherein 2 singles and 1 doubles will be conducted
- Only one player is allowed to play 2 matches all the other players can play only one match each
- Each set will be of 15/21 points each.

3) Basketball (Men & Women)

- The team should consist of minimum 6 and maximum 9 members each
- Ball will be provided by the college
- The match will be played on college basketball court.

4) Chess (Men & Women)

- The team should consist of minimum 3 and maximum 6 members each.
- Chess board will not be provided by the college each department should carry at least 3 chess boards also have to download a time clock in their own phone clock will not be provided by the college.
- One point will be provided for winning the match, 0.5 points will be provided for a tie and 0 points for losing.
- The matches will be in the a 3v3 team matches with 10+2 time format. If a match ends in a tie for whole team, a time scramble match will be played between the first player of both the teams if it is also a tie then match will be played between second player of both the teams and so on till the result conclusion.



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5) Football (Men & Women)

- The team should consist of minimum 13 and maximum 15 members each (for men) and for women the matches will be box football 5 a side and minimum 6 and maximum 8 players will be allowed
- Ball will be provided by the college
- The match will be played on college football ground
- Each Half will be of 10-15 minutes each
- The finals can have halves of 20 minutes each

6) Table-Tennis (Men & Women)

- The team should consist of minimum 3 and maximum 6 members each.
- The table tennis balls will be provided by the college and students have to carry their own racket & equipment.
- The matches will be best of 3 and all will be singles & the team to reach 3 points first will win.
- The format will be ABC vs XYZ and reverse if the score is not 3-0.
- Each set will be of 11 points each.

7) Volleyball (Men & Women)

- The team should consist of minimum 8 and maximum 10 members each
- Ball will be provided by the college
- The matches will be in best of 3 mode
- The Set will be of 15 points each

8) Cricket (Staff)

- The team should consist of minimum 12 members and maximum 15 members each
- The match will be of 8-10 over each
- The match will be played with tennis ball
- Balls and other equipment's like stumps, bails, etc will be provided by the college but staff are allowed to carry their own equipment's as well

9) Kabaddi (Men & Women)

- The team should consist of a minimum of 10 members and a maximum of 14 members each.
- The match will be played according to the official AKFI rules.
- Each match will consist of two halves of 20 minutes each.
- The Kabaddi court and required equipment will be provided by the college.
- All players must carry a valid college ID card and report 30 minutes before the match
